

Craftsman 910 W. 5th Street

The Arts & Crafts Movement was popular at the turn of the 20th century, and unaffected that it seems to blend with any landscape. The style which was billed as the "California bungalow" featured overhanging eaves, a low-slung gabled roof, and wide front porches framed by pillars. This house features exposed rafters and a flared base chimney.
